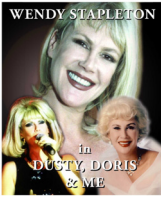
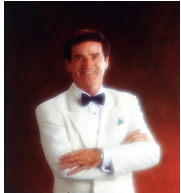


MECC MORNING MELODIES 2010
