ENTRY FORMS
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All registration applications must be completed and returned to Childhood Cancer Support (CCS) by post no later than 22/09/2011. 2. Entry is confirmed after full payment of entry invoice. 3. After entry has been confirmed, you will be contacted to arrange commencement of sponsor/supporter benefits. (e.g. Inclusion of logos and promotional materials)
SPONSOR/TEAM REGISTRATION PAYMENTS
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applications are considered on a first in, best dressed basis. 2. Invoices will be generated upon acceptance. 3. Entry is confirmed with full payment of entry invoice.
JUDGING AND WINNING
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The winning raft will be the first raft in its class to cross the finish line. 2. The judging panel will have final decision in the case of a dispute.
THE PRIZE
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 1st place: Name of organization to be engraved on the perpetual trophy. The trophy can be kept with winning organization for up to one year, but must be returned at least one week before the following annual raft race. 2. 1st place: Framed photo-finish to be presented at the 2012 trophy handover. 3. All participants and participating organisations will receive a certificate of appreciation from Childhood Cancer Support Inc. 4. Novelty prizes to be presented at the festival.
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All participants must be 16 years or older and deemed physically fit for this activity. 2. Liability release must be completed prior to participation. (Participants enter at their own risk.) 3. The CCS flag must be flown on raft and CCS posters put up in the work place. (Flag and posters supplied in supporters pack) 4. All safety guidelines and directives by authorized personnel must be adhered to. 5. Participating organizations and participants (collectively participants) of the raft race may be filmed, photographed, and/or interviewed leading up to, during, and after the raft race. Participants acknowledge and consent to this. Participants further agree that Childhood Cancer Support Inc. may use these materials for promotional and other purposes without further consent being obtained.
SAFETY
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rafts MUST be trialed and proven to float prior to the race. 2. Rafts may be constructed of any materials deemed fit to float and safely carry the participants to the finish line. No motors allowed. (bilge pumps excepted) No components that may entrap a participant. 3. Rafts must be fitted with tow points at each end and lift points for crane sling. (both tow and lift points to be painted red). 4. All participants must be properly fitted with an approved Personal Floatation Device (e.g. life jacket) 5. Safety glasses must be worn by all competitors on raft. 6. Emergency services and safety personnel will be on duty for the duration of the raft race. All instructions must be adhered to. 7. Physical removal of any participant from their raft is strictly prohibited.
BATTLE AMMUNITION

1. Common-sense approach to ammunition required. Water is preferred.
2. Battle ammunition must be suitable for keeping both people and the environment safe.
3. Please avoid injury to others and the environment.
4. NO HARD OBJECTS OR MATERIALS (e.g. no green tomatoes, no eggs)
5. NO OBJECTS OR FLUIDS THAT HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO CAUSE INFECTIONS (e.g. no manure)
6. River-Friendly ammunition only. Please ensure all materials used will not damage our precious environment and the creatures that inhabit it.
7. All battle ammunition will be inspected on race day, please ensure yours conforms to regulations.

Memorial Class

New to the Mackay Raft Race this year is the Memorial Class. This came about as a way of getting a wider variety of businesses unable to build their own rafts, to participate in the race.

Through the generosity of Absolute Enterprises who came up with the idea and had the workshop and with the help of Porters Hardware and Singles Transport, who have donated some materials and expertise, they have built Childhood Cancer Support 4 rafts (not to mention giving themselves more competition).

Each raft will be named after a Mackay regional child who has been affected by childhood cancer. With the rafts remaining the property of Childhood Cancer Support.

A raft is available to view at Absolute Enterprises prior to race day. All that is required from you is to add your finishing touches, decorations, lifejackets and some form of paddles, along with loads of team spirit and tons of energy. This can be done on the race day morning or if you require the raft for fundraising etc. prior to the race, arrangements can be made.

What's included in the \$1,250: Basically \$500.00 is a direct donation to Childhood Cancer Support which gets you the basic raft, ready for your finishing touches. And the \$750.00 is for the entry fee.
